About the Fund

Doc Seaman has been described as a hero, icon, pioneer, philanthropist, visionary and legend. On the list of his many achievements, he was an original owner of the Calgary Flames and was instrumental in bringing them to Calgary in 1980. Doc's love for hockey and sports, and his dedication to community will leave a lasting legacy for years to come.

In accordance of the Will of Daryl K Seaman, the purpose of grants from the Daryl K Seaman Canadian Hockey Fund is to support

- all aspects of amateur ice hockey in Canada on a nation-wide basis;
- registered Canadian amateur athletic associations; and
- other general charitable purposes as the Board of Directors of The Calgary Foundation shall determine.

Application Guidelines

- Applications will only be considered from Qualified Donees under the Income Tax Act of Canada, to support their own charitable work. To see what kinds of organizations are Qualified Donees, go to <http://www.charitycentral.ca/node/305>
- The fund is an endowment fund thus only a portion of the interest will be spent each year. In 2010, the total amount of grants will not exceed \$250,000.
- Multi-year commitments may be considered.
- Both large and small project proposals will be of interest.
- Proposals will preferably be for activities taking place after the decision date of December 31, 2010.

How to Apply

- The application is available at thecalgaryfoundation.org, under *Grants & Awards → Additional Granting Programs*.
- Only applications using this template will be considered.
- Applications must be sent by email to doc@thecalgaryfoundation.org and received no later than noon **MST on October 15, 2010**. Late applications will not be considered.

- Please also include the following attachments with your electronic submission:
 - Board members, their year of election and contact information
 - Staff list and positions
 - Audited financial statements for the last fiscal year
 - Current annual budget (revenue & expenses)
- Once you have sent your application electronically, you must send one complete hard copy, including the contact information and signature of the Qualified Donee's Board Chairperson by **October 23, 2010**.
- A Grants Advisory Committee will review proposals, and final decisions will be made by the Board of Directors of The Calgary Foundation.
- Decisions will be announced by December 31, 2010.
