- Have good academic standing.

Applicants must provide:

- Artist's statement and vision;
- A maximum of eight electronic images of work, burnt to CD-ROM and numbered. Each image must be a JPEG with a maximum of 1024 pixels, 72 dpi in resolution;
- A text file or hard-copy attachment that details the title, year, medium and size of each work;
- Two letters of reference (one must be from a studio professor).
