



Michael Gee Scholarship Fund Award

Deadline: March 31

The award is based on athletic (hockey) and academic performance. The recipient will be eligible to claim the scholarship funds when entering post-secondary. The value of this scholarship is \$1500. The applicant must be:

- A male or female, 15-18 years old.
- Calgary resident playing hockey in the Calgary Minor Hockey Association – Midget Boys A, AA, AAA, Midget Girls A or AAA.
- A student who has achieved a minimum of 85% in his/her educational institution.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Part One – Coach’s Nomination: Each coach will nominate the most deserving player from their team. Please evaluate the applicant relative to other players at the same level. The applicant must have a one-page letter of nomination from his/her coach who should evaluate the applicant on fair play and sportsmanship, leadership potential, athletic ability, and overall coachability and responsibility.

Part Two – Application Form: The applicant will complete the application form and submit it along with the coach’s nomination form, Part I. Submit application form by March 31, at 4:30 pm to:

The selected recipient will be notified and will be presented with the scholarship in the spring. Upon entry to post-secondary, the student must provide confirmation of enrollment to the Student Awards Administrator. Scholarship money will be advanced directly to the educational institution designated by the recipient. The institution will apply the scholarship funds towards tuition. Typically, recipients must collect their award before the age of 25; exceptions may be allowed if recipients continue to participate full-time in hockey beyond the age of 25 years.
